# **EVERGREENS**

## **CANAAN FIR \*New for 2024**

Densely branched conical tree with short dark blue green needles. Good for windbreaks. Full sun to part shade. Prefers moist, well-drained, sandy loam soils. May grow 55 feet tall by 25 feet wide, with a medium growth rate.

### **COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE**

Display of blue or blue-silver needles. Prefers moist (not wet), acidic soils. Drought resistant once established. Good for windbreaks; long-lived. Full sun. May grow 75 feet tall by 20 feet wide, with a slow to moderate growth rate.

## **NORWAY SPRUCE**

Stiff needles, drooping foliage. Adapts to a variety of soils, and is generally a healthy, care free tree. Easy to transplant. Full sun to part shade. May grow 60 feet tall by 30 feet wide, with a rapid growth rate.

# WHITE SPRUCE

A straight tall tree easily recognized by its needles. Cones always hang down. Good for windbreaks and used for Christmas trees. Beautiful year round color. Full sun. May grow 60 feet tall by 20 feet side, with a medium growth rate.

## **EASTERN REDCEDAR**

Dense pyramid shape, excellent for windbreaks and screens. Aromatic. Birds love its berries. Full sun. May grow 50 feet tall by 20 feet wide with a medium growth rate.

# **GREEN GIANT ARBORVITAE \*New for 2024**

A large, woody, needled evergreen tree. Tolerates a wide range of soils; low maintenance. Full sun to part shade. May grow 60 feet tall by 18 feet wide with a rapid growth rate of up to 3 feet per year.

# **DECIDUOUS**

## **PAWPAW**

This small tree is easily recognized by its large, tropical-looking foliage and prized for its delicious fruits that mature in late summer. Needs partial shade for establishment. Prefers moist, well drained soils. May grow 40 feet tall by 15 feet wide, with a moderate growth rate.

# WHITE FLOWERING DOGWOOD

Excellent landscape choice. White flowers in spring, vibrant red-purple foliage in fall, glossy red fruit attracts winter songbirds. May grow 25 feet tall by 25 feet wide, with a moderate growth rate.

## CHINKAPIN OAK \*New for 2024

A member of the white oak family with chestnut type leaves. It is tolerant of alkaline soils. Does best in moist to dry well-drained soils. Makes a good shade tree. Thrives in full sun. May grow 60 feet tall by 70 feet wide, with a medium growth rate.

#### **RED OAK**

Major timber tree, also an important shade tree in landscaping. Brilliant fall color. This native thrives in part to full sun. Prefers moist, well-drained soils. May grow 75 feet tall by 60 feet wide, with a rapid and vigorous growth rate.

#### WHITE OAK

Long-lived oak with showy fall foliage. Medium-sized acorns favored by deer. Prefers moist, well drained soils. Full sun to part shade. May grow 80 feet tall by 80 feet wide with a slow growth rate.

## **SHAGBARK HICKORY**

Native to most of the Eastern US. Has superior drought tolerance. Prefers deep, moist, rich, well-drained soils. Hickory nuts are edible. May grow 100 feet tall by 40 feet wide, with a moderate growth rate.

#### **RED MAPLE**

Popular shade tree with brilliant red fall color. Commonly found along creeks and bottomlands. Prefers moist to wet soils. Full sun to part shade. May grow 60 feet tall by 50 feet wide, with a medium to rapid growth rate.

## **SUGAR MAPLE**

Favorite shade tree with reliable fall color. Valued for its hard, dense, difficult-to-split wood. Can be used for maple sugaring. Prefers full to partial sun and well-drained soils. May grow 80 feet tall by 40 feet wide, with a slow growth rate.

# **TULIP POPLAR**

Named for its showy flowers and the silhouette of its large leaves, both of which resemble a tulip. Has a straight trunk. Prefers evenly moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils. Full sun. May grow 80 feet tall by 40 feet wide, with a rapid growth rate.

# **BLACK ELDERBERRY**

A native suckering shrub. Tiny lemon scented flowers fire way to black fruits that can be used to make jams, jellies, pie fillings and wine. May grow 12 feet tall by 12 feet wide, with a medium to rapid growth rate.

#### **COMMON LILAC**

Highly fragrant, spring-flowering shrub or small tree. This plant grows rapidly to fill its space. It makes excellent cut flowers. Tolerant of different soil types. Full sun to part shade. May grow 16 feet high by 12 feet wide with a medium growth rate.

#### **COMMON NINEBARK \*New for 2024**

A cold hardy, tough, native shrub for mixed borders. Pinkish-white flower clusters in late spring, persistent seed capsules and exfoliating bark adds to the seasonal interest. Full sun to part shade. Moist, well-drained soils. May grow up to 8 feet tall with a medium growth rate.
