

EVERGREENS

CANAAN FIR

Densely branched conical tree with short dark blue green needles. Good for windbreaks. Full sun to part shade. Prefers moist, well-drained, sandy loam soils. May grow 55 feet tall by 25 feet wide, with a medium growth rate.

COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE

Display of blue or blue-silver needles. Prefers moist (not wet), acidic soils. Drought resistant once established. Good for windbreaks; long-lived. Full sun. May grow 75 feet tall by 20 feet wide, with a slow to moderate growth rate.

NORWAY SPRUCE

Stiff needles, drooping foliage. Adapts to a variety of soils, and is generally a healthy, care free tree. Easy to transplant. Full sun to part shade. May grow 60 feet tall by 30 feet wide, with a rapid growth rate.

EASTERN RED CEDAR

Dense, pyramid shape, excellent for windbreaks and screens. Aromatic. Birds love its berries. Full sun. May grow 50 feet tall by 20 feet wide with a medium growth rate.

WHITE CEDAR (AMERICAN ARBORVITAE)

Scale-like leaves that are soft. Adapts well to shaping and shearing. Creates a low maintenance hedge. Provides cover for birds year round. Prefers moist, alkaline soils in partial to full sun. May grow 30 feet tall by 10 feet wide, with a medium growth rate.

GREEN GIANT ARBORVITAE

A large, woody, needled evergreen tree. Tolerates a wide range of soils; low maintenance. Full sun to part shade. May grow 60 feet tall by 18 feet wide with a rapid growth rate of up to 3 feet per year.

DECIDUOUS

PAWPAW

This small tree is easily recognized by its large, tropical-looking foliage and prized for its delicious fruits that mature in late summer. Needs partial shade for establishment. Prefers moist, well drained soils. May grow 40 feet tall by 15 feet wide, with a moderate growth rate.

PAPER BIRCH

This native has a distinctive bark and golden fall color. Grows well in acidic, loamy, moist, sandy, well-drained and clay soils. May grow 70 feet tall by 35 feet wide, with a moderate to fast growth rate.

CHINKAPIN OAK

A member of the white oak family with chestnut type leaves. It is tolerant of alkaline soils. Does best in moist to dry well-drained soils. Makes a good shade tree. Thrives in full sun. May grow 60 feet tall by 70 feet wide, with a medium growth rate.

RED OAK

Major timber tree, also an important shade tree in landscaping. Brilliant fall color. This native thrives in part to full sun. Prefers moist, well-drained soils. May grow 75 feet tall by 60 feet wide, with a rapid and vigorous growth rate.

WHITE OAK

Long-lived oak with showy fall foliage. Medium-sized acorns favored by deer. Prefers moist, well drained soils. Full sun to part shade. May grow 80 feet tall by 80 feet wide with a slow growth rate.

SHAGBARK HICKORY

Native to most of the Eastern US. Has superior drought tolerance. Prefers deep, moist, rich, well-drained soils. Hickory nuts are edible. May grow 100 feet tall by 40 feet wide, with a moderate growth rate.

RED MAPLE

Popular shade tree with brilliant red fall color. Commonly found along creeks and bottomlands. Prefers moist to wet soils. Full sun to part shade. May grow 60 feet tall by 50 feet wide, with a medium to rapid growth rate.

SUGAR MAPLE

Favorite shade tree with reliable fall color. Valued for its hard, dense, difficult-to-split wood. Can be used for maple sugaring. Prefers full to partial sun and well-drained soils. May grow 80 feet tall by 40 feet wide, with a slow growth rate.

DAWN REDWOOD

A deciduous conifer producing small, round 1/2" to 1" cones. It has a neat pyramidal shape in youth, maturing to a more round crown. The bright green, feathery leaves turn orange/reddish-brown in fall. Grows very rapidly, 100 feet tall with 25 foot spread.

BALD CYPRESS

This native deciduous conifer features short needles arranged in pairs. Develops cypress knees in wet conditions. Prefers full sun and is adaptable to wet or dry conditions. May grow 70 feet tall by 25 feet wide, with a moderate growth rate.

EASTERN REDBUD

A springtime favorite for its early purple buds followed by heart-shaped leaves. Sun to part shade. Prefers moist, well drained soils. May grow 30 feet tall by 35 feet wide with a slow growth rate.

BLACK ELDERBERRY

A native suckering shrub. Tiny lemon scented flowers fire way to black fruits that can be used to make jams, jellies, pie fillings and wine. May grow 12 feet tall by 12 feet wide, with a medium to rapid growth rate.

FRUITS

EARLIGLOW STRAWBERRIES - *JUNE BEARING*

A variety of strawberry that produces fruit that has a firm, glossy skin, firm flesh and medium size. Its sweet flavor makes the variety excellent for fresh eating and freezing. Vigorous and runner well. Recommended for beginners.

SEASCAPE STRAWBERRIES - *EVERBEARING*

High productive over a long season, yielding large, delicious berries with excellent flavor. This ever-bearing strawberry has good disease resistance and produces well in a wide range of climates. Full sun. Keep soil moist, but not soggy. Quickly reaches 12- inches tall, spreading 12-24 inches wide.
