2026 Scholarship for Agriculture & Natural Resources

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage promising students to enter the fields of agriculture or natural resources and to prepare them for such a career through an organized program of study at an Ohio college or university. This scholarship is awarded in memory of Douglas Steinbrunner and his more than 30 years of service to the Darke Soil and Water Conservation District.

QUALIFICATIONS - Applications will be accepted from students meeting the following qualifications:

1. A 2026 graduate of a Darke County public or private high school,
2. At the time of application, applicant must have a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale, or equivalent,
3. Planning to enroll full-time at a two or four-year Ohio college, technical school or university in Fall 2026,
4. Planning to pursue degree in an agricultural or natural resource related field.
5. Financial need is NOT a consideration for this scholarship.

Some qualifying fields of study are, but not limited to:

Agronomy	Resource Management
Forestry	Wildlife Management
Agricultural Engineering	Fisheries Management
Environmental Engineering	Agricultural Education/Communication
Land-Use Planning	Environmental Education/Communication
Soil Science	Environmental Science
Plant Science	Animal Science

Other fields of study will be considered subject to the approval of the Darke SWCD. The Darke SWCD reserves the right to withhold scholarship if applications received don't meet qualifications.

CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP - The scholarship award is for \$1,000 and will be processed through the College or University scholarship office and will be available to the student in January 2027 after proof of the student's continuing enrollment at the school has been obtained.

The selection committee reserves the right to refuse the application due to any of the following: incomplete application, essay and recommendation letter content, field of study selection and/or previous scholarship earnings.

The recipient will be acknowledged at his/her school graduation, at a Darke SWCD board meeting, annual meeting and banquet and in the Darke SWCD e-newsletter.

Completed applications must be received at the Darke SWCD office by 4:00pm on April 17, 2026.
